Rule out secondary causes of tics: Genetic - eg, Huntington's chorea, Klinefelter's syndrome. Acquired - eg, encephalitis, CVA, hyperthyroidism, CO poisoning, streptococcus-induced autoimmune Tourette's syndrome. Primary neuropsychiatric disorders - eg, schizophrenia.

Tourette syndrome (TS) is a neurological disorder characterized by repetitive, stereotyped, involuntary movements and vocalizations called tics. The disorder is named for Dr. Georges Gilles de la Tourette, the pioneering French neurologist who in 1885 first described the condition in an 86-year-old French noblewoman.

Other conditions and neuropsychological deficits associated with TS may include Autism Spectrum Disorder, substance use disorders, Oppositional Defiance Disorder, learning disabilities, memory deficits, Panic Disorder, social skills deficits, visual-perceptual motor disabilities and epilepsy.

Tourette syndrome referred to as Tourette disorder in the recently updated Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM – 5), is a common neurodevelopmental disorder affecting up to 1% of the population. It is characterized by multiple motor and vocal tics and starts in childhood. Children with Gilles de la Tourette syndrome (GTS) sometimes experience physical pain, social isolation, emotional disturbance, and are at risk for underachievement.

Chronic tic disorders such as Tourette syndrome are common, affecting approximately 1% of youth. Patients often outgrow their symptoms or gain better control of their tics as they get older. “ The prefrontal cortex gets stronger as we age, and that might be why patients have better control, ” Dr. Zea Vera says.
